Well, we are a local community workshop, based in the grounds of St James Church, off Low Lane. Our charity aims to reduce loneliness isolation and to promote social inclusion.

Our workshop is well equipped, with a full range of **woodworking machinery** and hand tools but possibly more important is the light and airy **kitchen social area**. I think its fair to say whilst we love a new project, **people are our priority.** So there's always coffee in the pot and an opportunity to chat and make **new friends**.

We manage our workshop sessions with a strong **team** of Shed Supervisors. Many of our team are ex Design & Technology Teachers and three of our team have worked extensively with children with Special Educational Needs. Aside from myself the team are all volunteers. All of our Shed supervisors have been through the safer recruiting process and carry an Enhanced DBS to work with children & vulnerable adults.

We have only been open since October but we have already worked with **groups** and **individuals** ranging from 13-81 years of age.

Who can get involved with the Shed?

We welcome enquiries from:-

- Other service providers who also aim to reduce loneliness and isolation and to promote social inclusion.
- Individuals who are perhaps feeling isolated or struggling with their mental health and would like to learn some skills in a supportive environment.
